FAMILY-FRIENDLY ENVIRONMENTS

▶ STRATEGIES

- 1. Have an open-door policy. Parents should be welcome and encouraged to visit anytime.
- 2. Display information about teachers and photos of them.
- 3. Display photos of children/families in the classroom and center.
- 4. Provide adult seating in the classroom for families.
- 5. Families should be encouraged to participate in a variety of ways (attend a program or event, have lunch with their child, volunteer in the classroom, etc.)
- 6. Provides families with opportunities to use their knowledge, skills and talents in the classroom and throughout the program.
- 7. Adopt policies that put family needs first.
- 8. Embrace diversity of the families you serve.
- 9. Respond to family needs.
- 10. Avoid making families feel vulnerable or inadequate.
- 11. Establish ties of trust.
- 12. Ask parents for information about their child and the child's interests to help plan daily activities.
- 13. Provide information on community activities or information on support services.
- 14. Create occasional social activities for center staff and families.
- 15. Use staff-experiences to "bring family-friendly elements to life."
